

# LEGGY HANGING SPIDER



You will need:

- 2 paper plates
- Coloured paper
- Small piece of card
- Paint
- Googly eyes (optional)
- Scissors
- Glue
- String/wool
- Sellotape

1. Paint the undersides of the 2 paper plates and leave to dry – we chose blue but you could choose whichever colour you like



2. Cut eight strips of paper 30cm long and 2.5cm wide – we chose to use different colours, but you could just use the same colour as your plates

3. Use tape to attach the strips to the unpainted side of one of your plates, 4 on each side, poking out from the centre



4. Cut a circle out of card and attach goggle eyes, or draw eyes on at the front. You could also use round stickers.



5. Tape the head to the unpainted side of the paper plate as you did the legs

6. Glue the unpainted side of the other paper plate and press it on to the plate with the legs and head attached, so that the painted sides show on both plates

7. Attach string to the top plate using tape and hang up!
